Code of Conduct

Pinnguaq Association believes learners, volunteers, trainers, and employees have the right to participate in an environment that is respectful, safe, and positive. With this right comes the responsibility to ensure a respectful, safe, and positive experience for everyone involved in any programming we lead. The following Code of Conduct is designed to provide you and your child with that security. This Code of Conduct applies to all participants in any activities at the Pinnguaq Makerspace operated by the Pinnguaq Association.

Participants are expected to adhere to the Code of Conduct detailed below and explained during the first day of a scheduled session and posted for display at the Makerspace.

Expected Behavior

Everyone who uses the Makerspace must be mindful of and take responsibility for their behaviour while at the Makerspace. This includes:

- Always acting out of respect and concern for others.
- Actively listening to others.
- Always respect the physical and personal space of the those in the Makerspace. Allow all students full opportunities to participate in all activities to the best of their abilities.
- Not using words that are racist, sexist, homophobic, classist or transphobic..
- Humbly accepting respectful correction (or correcting yourself!), keeping in mind that the impact of your words on other people is more important than your intent.

Unacceptable Behavior

Abusive behavior, harassment or destructive behavior towards anyone using the Makerspace is not acceptable.

Users of the Makerspace must not intentionally damage or alter any part of the building, inside or out, including furniture, equipment, or other people's belongings.

Enforcement

Anyone asked to stop unacceptable behavior is expected to comply immediately.

Anyone who engages in sustained unacceptable behavior may be sanctioned or permanently expelled from the community without warning (and without refund in the case of a paid event.)

Understanding of code of conduct

I have read and understand the Maker Space Code of Conduct and I agree to following the expectations within it and/or ensuring my child follows the expectations.

Release of Liability

IN CONSIDERATION of my child being permitted to participate in the activities at the Pinnguaq Association's Pinnguaq Makerspace (referred to hereinafter as the "Makerspace"), I for myself, and on behalf of my personal representatives, assigns, heirs, estate, executors, administrators, and next of kin, (the "Releasors") hereby FULLY AND FOREVER RELEASE AND DISCHARGE the Pinnguaq Association, and its respective administrators, directors, employees, agents, officers, and students (including, without limitation, other related parties and any volunteers, other participants, sponsors, advertisers, the owner and lessors of the premises on which the Makerspace takes place, and all of their respective successors and assigns) (collectively, the "Released Parties") from any and all losses, damages, injuries (including death), or damage or loss to property, howsoever occurring, whether by negligence or otherwise, claims, demands, lawsuits, expenses, (including legal fees and disbursements), and any other liability of any kind, of or to me or any other person, directly or indirectly arising out of or in connection with my child's participation in and attendance at the Makerspace. This means that the Released Parties cannot be held liable for any loss, damage, or injury (including death) that my child may experience related to, or arising from, participation in the Makerspace.

I/we have read, understood and agreed to the foregoing. I/we warrant that I/we am/are the parent(s) or legal guardian(s) of the individual named in the above release form who is a minor and that I/we am/are entitled to sign this release form. I/we indemnify Pinnguaq Association, and its successors and assigns against any loss or claim if the minor disavows the release form because the minor was a minor or for any other similar grounds.
