

Pinnguaq COVID-19 Procedures for Participants

1. Vaccination Requirement

- Participants are not required to demonstrate proof of vaccination to attend in-person programming.

2. Self Screening

- All Participants will be required to complete and pass the self screening [Makerspace Programming COVID-19 Screening Tool](#), before attending the Makerspace.
- Participants with any signs or symptoms of COVID-19 must not attend the workplace.

3. Masks and Sanitation

- Participants are not required to wear masks during programming.
- Participants will be encouraged to ensure regular and thorough hand-washing and good hygiene. Staff and visitors will have access to soap and water or alcohol-based sanitizer, hand sanitizer dispensers in prominent places around the workplace, and informational posters throughout the workplace.

4. Environmental Cleaning and Disinfecting

- Keeping the Makerspace clean and sanitized is vital. Frequent cleaning and disinfection will be implemented, focusing on high touch surfaces and equipment.

5. If a participant becomes ill during programming

- If a participant becomes ill at programming, they must go home.
- Staff will collect the participants belonging and take the learner to the front foyer, the co-facilitator will remain with the learner until the parent or legal guardian can pick them up

- Staff will contact the parent or legal guardian and notify them they must arrange for them to get home, in a way that does not include public transportation as soon as possible. We encourage you to have a plan for this ahead of time.
